Front of paper

Flip the paper over

Fold in half



04

Half again

Unfold previous step

Fold bottom left and right points diagonally upwards

Fold both top points toward bottom point

Unfold previous step



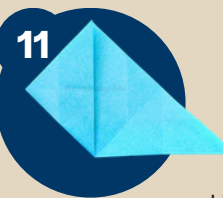

Fold left and right to centre

Unfold right section

Using the creases you just made, bring the right side in

Fold the right section back up, squashing the folds underneath



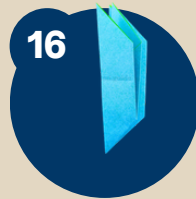

Repeat steps 11-13 on left side



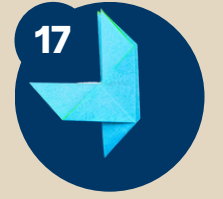

Flip over



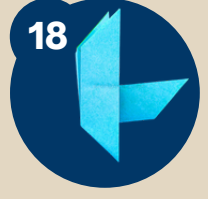

Fold in half, left edge over to right edge

Bring top layer diagonally down to the left

Flip over, from left to right

Bring top layer diagonally down to the right

Fold the flap diagonally over and down to the left



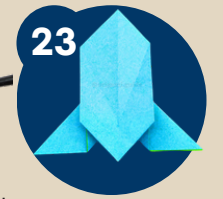

Bring the other flap down from behind to match

Fold the top point diagonally over to the left, using the creases underneath as a guide.



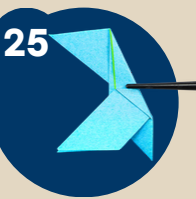

Open the model up a bit and place it in this position

Bring the two sides inwards

Flatten model again and rotate it to this position

Fold the bottom left flap diagonally up to the right



27

Bring the flap that is behind diagonally up to match



28

Rotate the paper

Inside reverse fold the head by pinching the top point and pulling it down

Flatten the head

The origami dove is completed
